

ICE SHED REJUVENATION PROGRAM

In the spirit of continuing the improvements of the Baie D'Urfé Curling Club, we are launching the Ice Shed Rejuvenation Donation Program. Your donation will go towards the costs associated with the purchase of the new ice scraper as well as the Provincial and Territorial landscapes and their framing. In conjunction with Curling Quebec and Sports Quebec, we are offering you an opportunity to not only support the Baie D'Urfé Curling Club, but to receive a tax receipt for the entire amount of your donation towards this Program. We are looking to raise \$15,000 with this program, which will continue until April, 2021.

This year, we have had to replace our aging ice scraper. Unfortunately, we could not coax another season from the old one, but we were able to find a second-hand model which had only seen one season of use!

The landscapes definitely spark Canadian pride, are bright, cheerful, and appreciated in the middle of winter! As you know, each landscape is positioned on the shed's wall next to the corresponding flag of the province or territory represented by the landscape. We have been working very hard to finalize this initiative with the framing of the landscapes.

As an extra incentive, for those who donate \$600 or more to this Program, the Club will recognize your support with an 8" x 10" plaque next to the landscape of your choice. We may need to limit the number of plaques per landscape, so please don't wait to donate!

All persons donating any amount of \$25 or more to this Program will be provided with a tax receipt from Sports Quebec in their name for the tax year that the donation was received. Attached is the donation form which contains the Program identification; this form must be completed and sent with your payment information. In return, the Club will receive a cheque in February 2021 for the amount of donations received in 2020, minus a small administration fee. Any donations made in 2021 will be forwarded to the club after the end of the program.

We ask that you send a copy of your completed form to Martine (accounting@bdcc.ca) so that we can track your donation. Those contributing \$600 or more will be contacted for your choice of landscape and text to appear on your recognition plaque. The plaques will remain in place for 10 years, at the end of which the original donor will be contacted to ask if they wish to renew their support.
